

Members of the High Council of Free Trade – Industrial Zones and its Authorization

- In order to bring about coordination among the Authorities of the Free Trade–Industrial Zones, a Council, chaired by the President and composed of the following persons, shall be established: The Ministers of: Economic Affairs and Finance, Commerce, Interior, Labor and Social Affairs, Industries and Mines, Roads and Transportation, Petroleum, Energy, Housing and Urban development, Culture and Islamic Guidance, the Head of Management and Plan Organization, the Governor of the Central Bank of the Islamic Republic of Iran, head of the Environment Protection Organization and the Secretary of the High Council of Free Trade–Industrial Zones.
- The responsibilities and powers of the Board of Ministers as stipulated in the Law on the Administration of Free Trade– Industrial Zones (excluding Note (3) of the Article (1) of the said Law), approved in 1372 (1993) shall be delegated to a commission composed of the Ministers subject of paragraph (1) of the Decree. The quorum for adoption of decisions by the commission shall consist of the majority of the members present and at least four members thereof. The decisions adopted by the commission shall be put into force, upon approval by the President, with observance of the Article (19) of internal procedures of the Cabinet.
- The Council and the Commission stipulated in the above Paragraphs (1) and (2) shall have a secretariat, which shall be administered by the Secretary of the said Council and the Commission who is appointed by President of the Republic.
